



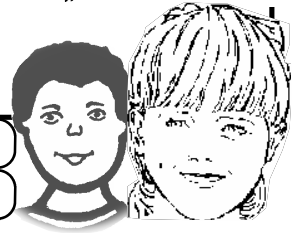

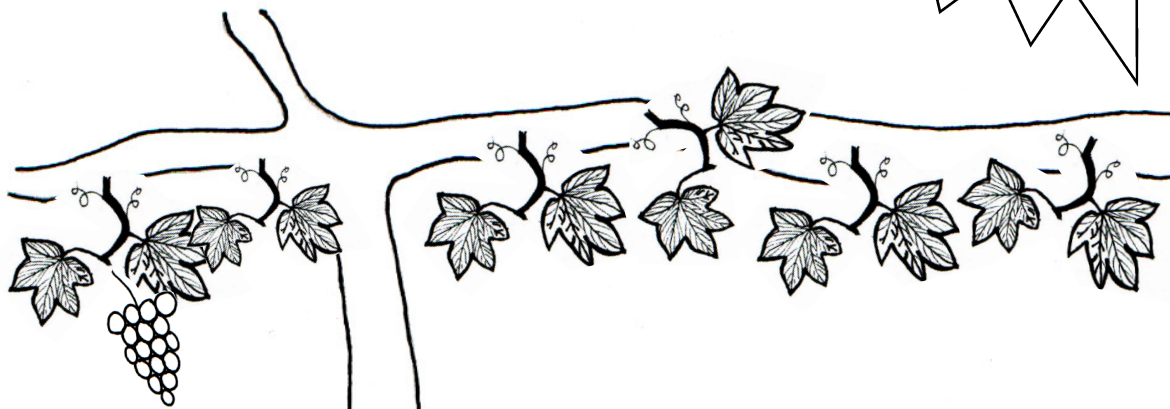
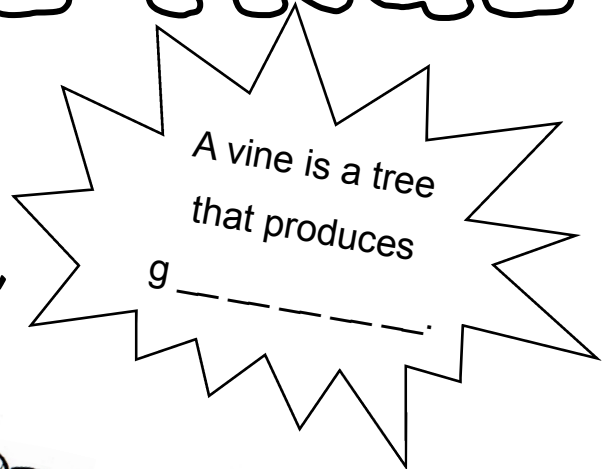

Draw more bunches of grapes on the branches of the vine.

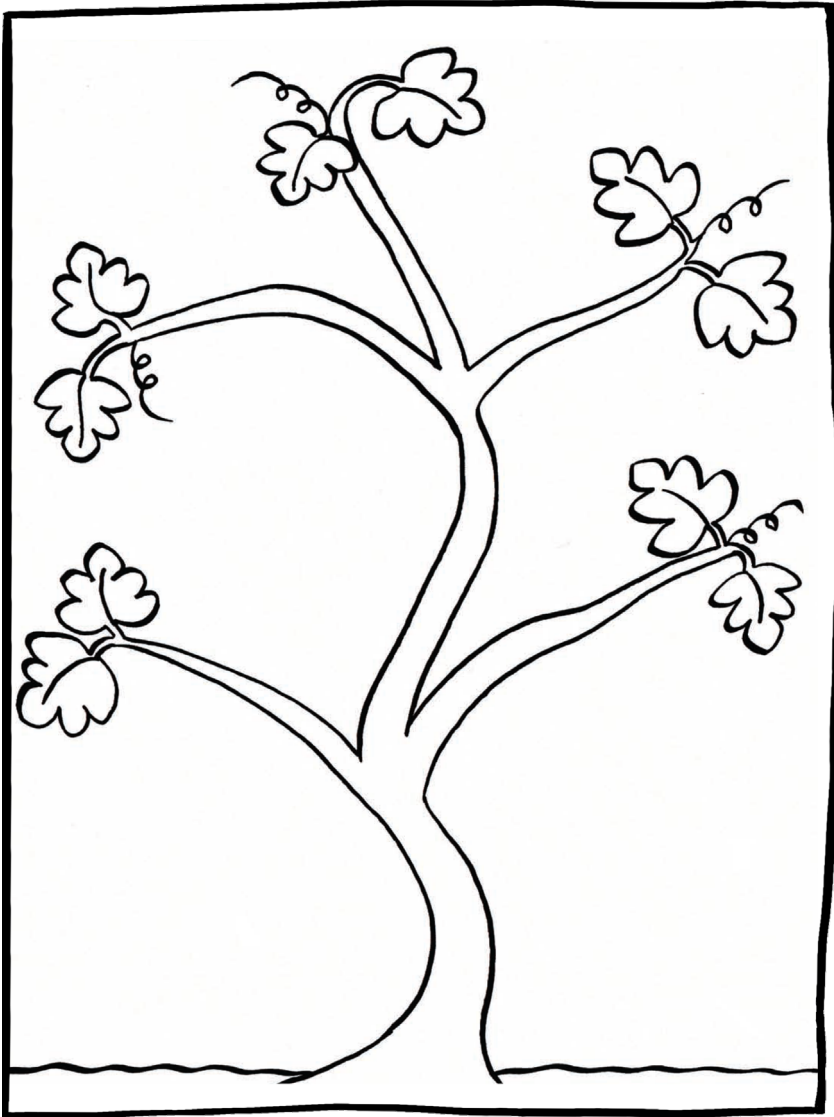
I can be a good branch and produce good fruit by ...

John 15:1-8

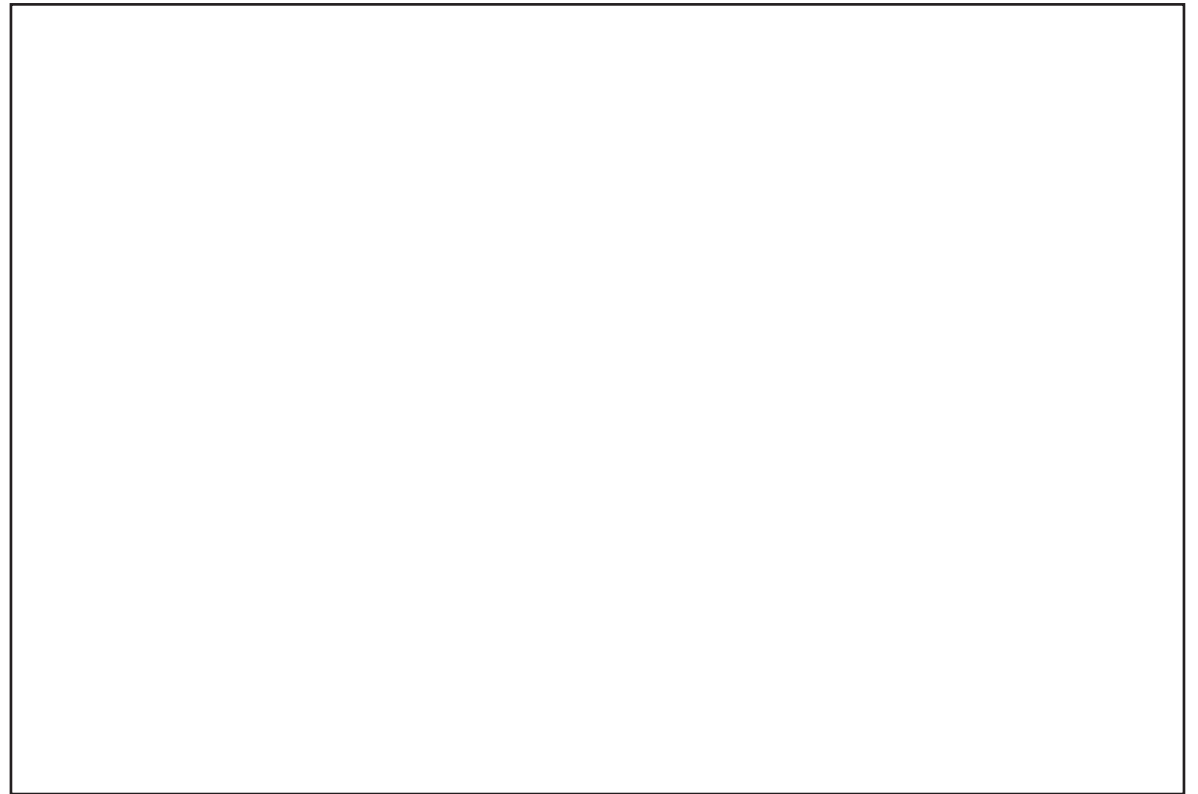
**“I am the vine, and you are the branches.”**
